SERVICE

The Service Committee helps recruit volunteers for many projects at both the Downtown and Community Campuses. The four Blood Drives per year (Winter, Spring, Summer, Fall) at each campus are our major projects. The next Downtown Campus blood drive is October 11th and 12th. The next blood drive at Community Campus is October 24th and 25th. Power Red (previously called double red cell donation) is done at the Community Campus blood drive. Power Red is similar to a whole blood donation, except that a special machine is used to allow a donor to safely donate a concentrated dose of red cells through a special machine with the plasma and platelets returned to the donor when completed.

The Committee had a busy summer assisting with the Beautification of Community Campus by planting flowers in the garden area in front of the hospital.

The Holiday season will be here before we know it and the upcoming projects include decorating at Community Campus and wrapping of gifts at Snowflake Central for hospitalized children in Golisano Children's Hospital.

The Service Committee is currently working on projects but definite details are incomplete at this time. When projects are complete we will be looking for help from Advocates and Volunteers.
