BERGSTROM SCHOLARSHIP

The Bergstrom Scholarship was established by pediatrician William H. Bergstrom in memory of his mother, Jesse, who was a registered nurse. Dr. Bergstrom is interested in assisting a nursing student with educational expenses for the purpose of career advancement.

This scholarship, which will be presented Saturday, May 17, 2008, at the College of Nursing Awards Ceremony, is given to a second year undergraduate Nursing student. The successful student will have completed between 25 and 30 credits toward the BS degree, have no outstanding "incompletes," and be in good academic standing.

BURTCH SCHOLARSHIP

The Burtch Scholarship for nursing education is made up of monies donated by the family of Robert Burtch, MD, a physician who practiced in the North Country for many years.

This scholarship, which will be presented on Saturday, May 17, 2008, at the College of Nursing Awards Ceremony, is given to an undergraduate Nursing student who has completed at least one semester (15 credits) towards the BS degree. The successful applicant will have no outstanding "incompletes," and will be in good academic standing.

SCHAAPMAN SCHOLARSHIP

Established in 1994, the Natalie Schaapman, RN, Scholarship is intended to assist registered nurses with educational expenses.

This scholarship, which will be awarded on Saturday, May 17, 2008, at the College of Nursing Awards Ceremony, will be given to a matriculated student who has completed a minimum of 12 undergraduate credits or who is continuing in graduate study. The successful applicant will have no outstanding "incompletes," and will be in good academic standing.

HELGA E. PEARSON SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship, which will be awarded on Saturday, May 17, 2008, at the College of Nursing Awards Ceremony, was established by Ingrid P. Pearson as a memorial to her mother to encourage the study of gerontological nursing. The successful applicant will have no outstanding "incompletes," and will be in good academic standing.
