UNITED STATES MEDICAL LICENSING EXAM (USMLE)

STEP 1 – Students must post a score within five weeks of their first day of their first clerkship, and post a passing score by January 1st of their third year.

STEP 2 – Students are required to take and post scores on both components of Step 2 prior to graduation. These scores must be available to the Registrar no later than one week prior to the graduation date.

The SUNY Upstate Medical University College of Medicine Course Selection Book is printed in the month of March prior to the academic year that it is referenced to (which runs from July through June of the following year). The Course Selection Book is printed as a convenient carry-around reference guide for students, faculty and staff.
