POLICY STATEMENT

As determined by the University, unauthorized persons are forbidden to loiter or trespass in University buildings or on campus grounds. In terms of enforcement, it should be noted that students are required to present identification upon request of University personnel (see ID cards), and overnight guests must be registered. While all University personnel are expected to be aware of this regulation and to assist in its enforcement, University Police personnel should be the authority to question a suspected loiterer or trespasser.
