

Faculty Information Systems - Annual Academic Expectations

The first step in developing a robust system to track faculty accomplishments is to improve our core system of Annual Academic Expectations. To that end, we have worked closely with Nicole Morgante and her team (Kristin Vella and others) to develop an online version of the Annual Academic Expectations (AAE). The system allows for tracking of accomplishments, input of the distribution of percents effort, and updating of new annual goals.

Each year, faculty will be reminded of the need to update their materials through Self-Serve. Faculty will be able to work collaboratively with their chairs or other designated "supervisor" to update prior years and submit their materials for review by the Office of Faculty Affairs. This process is the first step in the process to automate the work flow for promotions materials. It will allow us to track faculty work distributions across the campus as well as to track accomplishments. Stay tuned for more information about this launch.
