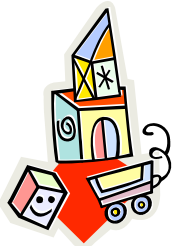

Please Remember:

- Toys are needed year round
- Our patients range in age from a few days to nineteen years old.
- Please do not wrap gifts. If you would like to include the wrapping materials in your donation separately, that would be fine.
- Be sure the toys meet safety guidelines.
- In order to respect the diverse individual beliefs of our families, we cannot accept any denominational or religious materials.



Toy Safety Guidelines:

- Only brand new stuffed toys can be accepted. Used stuffed toys or ones stored on shelves are not allowed. Toys stuffed with plastic pellets are allowed for children over 3 years old. Toys with detachable pieces are discouraged due to choking hazards.
- Fire regulations forbid electrical or spark producing toys.
- Avoid toys with sharp edges or points.
- No latex products please, latex balloons are also banned.
- Painted toys should be non-toxic.
- Toys should not have parts that can pinch skin or grab hair.
- Any glue or paint in craft kits must be non-toxic.
- Toys with many small parts are discouraged.
- “Humorous” or “gag” medical toys can cause confusion, misconception and fear, and are therefore not allowed.
- Due to infection control standards, we cannot accept any used stuffed animals or toys.
