SUNY Upstate Medical University's Summer Undergraduate Research Fellowship program

SUNY Upstate Medical University's Summer Undergraduate Research Fellowship program (SURF) is an opportunity to experience the excitement and sense of discovery to be found in a graduate-level scientific laboratory.

Participants will carry out research under the supervision of an established biomedical scientist, write a research paper and have the opportunity to see their work published.

Open to students majoring in chemistry, biology and related fields who have completed their junior year and who have a strong interest in pursuing a career in basic biomedical research. International students with a current J-1 or F-1 visa already attending school in the United States are eligible to apply.

The main criteria for the selection:

- · personal scholarship
- · academic excellence
- a match of applicant interests with those of participating Upstate researchers

In addition to the completed online application applicants will submit:

- a personal statement
- an official transcript of your undergraduate study to date
- two letters of recommendation from professors. related to your major, an advisor, and/or department chair

Each fellow will be provided a \$4,000 stipend for the 10-week period plus free university housing at the foot of Syracuse's "University Hill."

SURF Physician-Scientist Program (SURF PS)

(SURF PS) is a special pathway and admissions option for the Summer Undergraduate Research Fellowship. It is designed to share knowledge of the career path of a physician-scientist with students from backgrounds underrepresented in science and healthcare.

Along with the benefits all SURF fellows enjoy, SURF PS fellows will

- experience basic and translational science alongside a faculty research advisor and a MD/PhD student
- have the opportunity to shadow and join in weekly rounds with a physician

SURF Cancer Research Program (SURF CR)

The SUNY Upstate Medical University SURF Cancer Research Program (SURF CR) is another special pathway and admission option funded by SUNY Upstate's Cancer Center. This initiative is aimed at exposing undergraduates to basic, clinical, and translational cancer research, especially those students who are interested in pursuing a PhD (or MD/PHD) in cancer-related fields. Along with the benefits all SURF fellows enjoy, SURF PS fellows will have the opportunity to train in one of several cancer center laboratories with specialties that include i) cancer biology and genomics, ii) cancer prevention, detection, and diagnosis, and iii) cancer treatment and developmental therapeutics.

We are specifically looking for students interested in pursuing a PhD, MS, MD, MD/PhD, DNP, DPT, MPH, and Physician Assistant: MS. SURF HS fellows are paired with a faculty member in the Colleges of Medicine, Health Professions, or Nursing to learn more about those professions and to perform cutting edge research.

SURF PS, SURF CR and SURF HS fellows will apply alongside traditional SURF students.
