STATE HOLIDAY TYPE KEY:

#When a holiday falls on an employee's regularly scheduled day off (pass day), he/she (both NYS and RF employee) is entitled to equivalent time off (to be scheduled at a mutually convenient date) in lieu of the holiday (holiday leave); however, if a Classified Service State employee is scheduled or directed to work on any such Saturday, they may receive additional compensation in lieu of such compensatory time off in accordance with State rules.
