Structure:

Grading:

Shelf Exam - mostly (>83% H, >78% HP, >60% P)

Clinical Evaluations

OSCE – 30 min interview with a standardized patient, take-home written assignment.

Call: q 5 nights, from 5- 11 pm, alternates between UH/VA/HPC and CPEP @ St. Joe's

Typical Day:

Morning Meetings: M thru F, 8-9am in Rm 304 PBS. Students that were on call the previous night are expected to present an interesting case that they saw or present a topic that Dr. Haldipur will assign during the clerkship.
