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Patient care: Nursery Cleaning

Purpose: To keep nursery areas free of dirt and dust, and to ensure a clean environment. Cleaning cart must be in close proximity to cleaner at all times. When the cleaner leaves the area the cart is required to be secured.

Procedure:

1. Dress in accordance with hospital requirements.
2. Empty waste receptacles and clean with quat-stat solution. Insert new liners in all containers.
3. High dust ceiling lights, ledges, and vents.
4. Begin damp dusting ceiling, ledges and lights using quat-stat solution.
5. Wash walls as necessary using quat-stat solution.
6. Wash windows if necessary using quat-stat solution.
7. Damp dust counter tops, cabinets using quat-stat solution.
8. Clean sinks.
9. Place wet floor sign at entrance to room and remove when floor is dry.
10. Prepare to damp mop floor by moving aside furniture. Damp mop floor, beginning in far corner and working back toward entrance.
11. Refill all dispensers.
12. Clean and replace all equipment in a neat, orderly fashion.
13. Self inspect work.
