Carpet Bonnet Shampooing

Purpose: To remove the deeply ingrained layer of dirt that is held to the carpet fibers by an oily film - a layer that simple vacuuming doesn't reach. The bonnet buffing technique uses a rotary floor machine with a yarn pad.

- Procedure:**
1. Mix shampoo solution in accordance with manufacturer's instructions. Pour solution into hand pump sprayer.
 2. Spray carpeted area. Apply shampoo sparingly - too much of the solution will inhibit cleaning, and cause carpet to wick and appear dirtier than before.
 3. Center shampoo bonnet pad under machine and move machine slowly over carpet, concentrating on high soil areas.
 4. When one side of shampoo bonnet pad becomes soiled, turn it over.
X Never use the same pad on two different carpet colors without laundering between uses.
X Wash pads after each use.
 5. Let carpet dry thoroughly. Use a floor fan to quicken drying time if necessary.
 6. Vacuum.
 7. Return cleaning equipment, in a clean and orderly fashion.
 8. Self inspect work.
