Nursing Management and Clinical Practice

This award is campus-wide and includes all RN's and advanced practice nurses. Selection is made by a group of representatives of the 3RI Committee. The winner for each category will be selected based on who best meets the following criteria in either the clinical or managerial arena.

- ◆ Management and Fiscal Responsibility-Achieves fiscal/management targets and demonstrates accountability for unit/dept.
- ◆ Quality Management-Successfully develops and uses costs, quality, and satisfaction measures as outcome criteria to make improvements
- ◆ Standards, Certifications and Accreditations-Relevant standards, certifications and accreditations are incorporated into work objectives.
- ◆ Education-Fosters personal and professional development of self, colleagues and subordinates.
- ◆ Goals-Annual goals are accomplished and aligned with the nursing department strategic plan.
- ◆ Community-Active memberships in professional organizations and involvement in community and/or organizational events.
- ◆ Communication-Builds and maintains an effective interpersonal and organizational network. Communicates institutional and unit/dept. initiatives to management, associates and staff.
- ◆ Excellence in Practice-Innovations in practice (development of educational materials, research, efficiency, practice guidelines, management and fiscal responsibilities, etc...)
- ◆ Commitment to patient care and staff (to include safety, respect and compassion in practice)
