TRANSITIONING FROM INPATIENT TO CLINIC

LOCATION OF CLINIC:

- The Burn Clinic is located in the basement of the main hospital. Enter using the main circle, 750 East Adams Street. Take the main elevators to the basement. There you will see signs for the Surgical Specialties Clinic, the Burn Clinic is located there. You will see a check in and waiting area.

WHAT TO EXPECT FOR YOUR FIRST VISIT:

- After you check in, a nurse will meet you in the waiting area. Depending on the age of your child, the nurse may complete a blood pressure, temperature check, height and weight.
- Once in the exam room, the medical team will take off the existing dressing placed over the burned area. After this the medical team will be able to talk with you about the next step. This may include washing the area and placing a new dressing.

CHILD LIFE SPECIALIST:

- A child life specialist will meet with you prior to the start of the appointment. Our goal is to support you and your child during care with the burn team. Please let us know what has been or may be helpful for your child, including positioning during procedures or your child's favorite toys to keep them distracted.

MEDICAL TEAM:

- Please feel open to talk in conversation with the whole medical team about how your child has been doing at home and if you have any additional questions or concerns.
- Check with the medical team about giving your child medicine prior to arriving for your clinic appointment.
