- > Training must address [Health Care Preparedness and Response Capabilities for Health Care Coalitions](#) (formerly known as the “2017-2022 Health Care Preparedness and Response Capabilities”):
 - Foundation for Health Care and Medical Readiness
 - Health Care and Medical Response Coordination
 - Continuity of Health Care Service Delivery
 - Medical Surge
- > Training must address gaps and needs identified in regional HEPC plans.
- > Funds cannot be used to supplant costs for training or professional certifications that is a condition of employment.
- > Training activities may include but are not limited to:
 - Initial education
 - Continuing education
 - Appropriate certifications
 - Just-in-time training (JITT)
- > Conferences will be evaluated on an individual basis and should be:
 - A training or workshop
 - Topics and materials addressed should be specifically relevant and applicable to New York, i.e., lessons learned, case scenarios; and
 - Are in support of the Health Care Preparedness and Response Capabilities for Health Care Coalitions.
- > The request to add an additional training to the list must be submitted by a HEPC Lead to the OHEP Preparedness Training Manager.
- > Request to add an additional training must include justification that should address:
 - Name of training
 - Description of training
 - Regional HEPC training gap/need
 - Target audience
