Professional Role Development IV: Ethics and Advanced Leadership

3 Credits

This course focuses on the skills and knowledge needed by the Advanced Practice Nurse (APN) to function as a leader in healthcare. The course focuses on the development of individuals as informed and collaborative leaders within the healthcare system, with use of evidence-based research to promote improvement throughout the system. This class is designed to create an atmosphere of autonomy, personal responsibility, open-mindedness and continuous learning.

Emphasis is placed on the values of, health care equity, financial stewardship, policy analysis, and advocacy for patient dignity, quality and safety. This course is designed to offer both theoretical foundations of leadership and application of practical skills for nursing leaders.
