Eligible applications must have:

- A minimum cumulative and prerequisite 3.30 GPA with four of the eight required science prerequisite courses for the DPT program (www.upstate.edu/eadpt) completed by the end of the spring semester of their sophomore year with grades of "B" or higher within any major and at any accredited undergraduate institution.
- At least 40 hours of shadowing a physical therapist completed after high school graduation. Twenty of those hours must be completed with a single physical therapist.

The number of students admitted will vary by year.
