## EARLY ASSURANCE PROGRAM FOR COLLEGE FRESHMEN



The Early Assurance Program for College Freshmen is an opportunity for first-year college students interested in pursuing a bachelor's degree at SUNY Upstate Medical University to apply and receive a decision while in their freshman year of college.

Applicants can apply to one of the following bachelor's degree programs within the College of Health Professions:

- · Medical Biotechnology, BS
- · Medical Imaging Sciences/Radiography (X-ray), BS
- Medical Imaging Sciences/Ultrasound, BS or BPS
- · Medical Technology, BS
- · Radiation Therapy, BS or BPS
- · Respiratory Therapy, BS

## **Requirements and Recommendations for Applicants:**

- A recommended minimum unweighted high school average of 90, with an unweighted high school science average of 88.
- A recommended minimum cumulative GPA of 3.30 for all colleges courses by the end of the fall semester of their freshman year of college.

Applicants **must** be enrolled first year students at an accredited institution and begin college in the fall semester following high school graduation.
