Decisions SUNY Upstate Medical University

Thank you for your interest in SUNY Upstate!

Applicants typically receive a decision within a few weeks of their interview. Applicants will receive one of five decisions. Decisions are sent out via e-mail.

<u>Accept</u> – If admitted, applicants will receive an e-mail notification and then receive their acceptance letter and material in the student portal. The date the response is due by is noted on the acceptance letter. To accept the offer, applicants need to submit a tuition deposit by the due date. Additional steps, such as background checks, health forms information, etc. will be included.

<u>Rejected</u> – If rejected, applicants may schedule a post-advisement with an Admissions Advisor to discuss ways to strengthen their application, if they plan to re-apply. Post-advisements may be scheduled by calling 315-464-4570 or e-mailing admiss@upstate.edu.

<u>Hold for Information</u>* – If the Admissions Committee needs additional information to make a decision, we will notify the applicant of what is needed. It is the applicant's responsibility to submit the needed information. Once received, the application will be re-submitted to the Admissions Committee for a decision.

<u>Hold for Comparison</u>* – The Admissions Committee will hold the application and will make a decision after additional applicants have interviewed.

<u>Alternate List*</u> – The Alternate List is the list of applicants that the Admissions Committee goes to in order to fill places in the class if an admitted student decides not to attend. We cannot predict if we will fill any spaces in the class with students from the Alternate List nor how far down the list we may get. Also, we don't disclose how long the alternate list is or where an applicant is placed on the list.

* - Decisions with stars only apply to applicants applying Regular Admission. Decisions for applicants applying Early Admission as high school seniors are only accept or reject.

If accepted, Orientation will be held in late August. Attendance at Orientation is mandatory.
