APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL AID

You must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by going to <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/>.

FAFSA TIMELINE

The FAFSA is available October 1st of each year. Upstate's priority deadline to complete the FAFSA is March 1st.

USING PARENT'S INFORMATION ON THE FAFSA

We recommend that all medicine students provide their parental information if they wish to be considered for the institutional scholarships and grants from SUNY Upstate Medical University. This includes scholarships and tuition waivers for economically disadvantaged and EOP/HEOP graduates.

FINANCIAL AID PACKAGES

Students who submit a FAFSA by the priority deadline in the Medicine, DPT, and PA programs should have their financial aid packages by March 15th. Students in all other programs should have their financial aid packages by April 1st. All students with a FAFSA submitted after March 1st will receive their packages on a rolling basis, beginning in April.

ACCEPTING YOUR AID

Once your financial aid package is available, you should log on to MyUpstate to view and "accept" the financial aid that you will need to successfully finance your education.

COMPLETING YOUR LOAN DOCUMENTS

If this is your first time taking out a student loan through the Federal Direct student loan program, entrance counseling must be completed at www.studentloans.gov.

You must sign a Master Promissory Note (MPN) for your loans — one MPN for unsubsidized/subsidized and a separate note for the Grad Plus loans. Both are available at www.studentloans.gov.

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

Please send an email to finaid@upstate.edu explaining your situation:

- If you have extenuating circumstances which will impact your budget.
- If you are receiving a scholarship or grant from an outside organization.
- If you submitted your FAFSA on time and you have not received a package by the date outlined above.
- If you receive a notice that you have been selected for verification and need to submit documentation in order to complete the financial aid process.
