# Required Course Information

#### **POMI COURSE MATERIALS**

Preparing for the Course – Prior to, or during the first week of class, all students should:

- · Obtain the required text.
- Read the syllabus and familiarize yourself with the course schedule and assignment due dates.
- Familiarize yourself with the POM1 course materials found on the *Blackboard* site: http://bb.upstate.edu. All of the most up to date information can be found on the Blackboard site (including all course materials, weekly newsflashes with updates and any schedule changes).

### REQUIRED MEDICAL EQUIPMENT & SUPPLIES FOR STUDENTS TAKING THE POMI COURSE:

All can be obtained at the campus bookstore, unless otherwise specified.

- Students will be given a short white clinical coat at the "White Coat Ceremony" in your first few weeks at school.
  Students will be expected to wear their white coat during all clinical experiences and standardized patient encounters without exception.
- Stethoscope: Littmann Cardiology IV is recommended (available in numerous colors). Do not purchase an electronic stethoscope or one with three heads.
- Sphygmomanometer (BP cuff): Any non-digital model will suffice
- A 128 Tuning fork (for vibration testing)


- A 512 tuning fork (for auditory testing)
- Tape measure
- Penlight/pocket flashlight
- · Disposable wooden tongue depressors
- Reflex hammer
- Watch (digital or with a second hand) for assessing pulse and respiratory rates
- · Pocket Eye (Snellen) Chart/Ruler
- Oto-ophthalmoscope Diagnostic set (is an OPTIONAL purchase due to cost, but highly recommended so you can practice outside of the classroom) to examine the eyes, ears, nose and throat; I recommend any of the Welch Allyn Macroview sets (97200-MC, 97200-MS). The campus bookstore is not stocking the oto-ophthalmoscopes. You can purchase through an online vendor like Steeles Supply (http://www.steeles.com), and at Amazon: http://www.amazon.com
- Medical "doctor's bag" (or suitable substitute) to carry your equipment to each small group and clinical experience.
