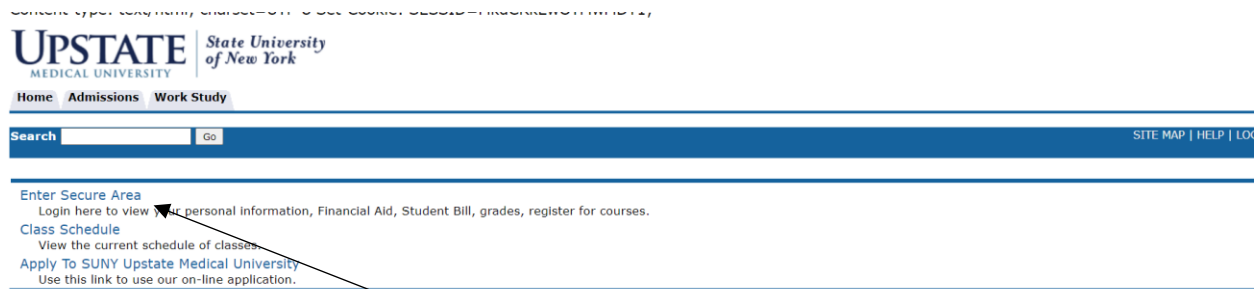

**(E=1)** Warrants immediate acceptance. An outstanding candidate. This candidate exhibits superior personal qualities during the interview and has demonstrated, through activities and involvements, an interest in and understanding of the medical profession, including scholarly pursuits, independent research, active involvement in community activities, humanitarian involvement.

**(A+=2)** Warrants acceptance; no lower than a High Priority Alternate letter. A very good to excellent candidate who is very acceptable. The candidate's personal traits are solid. During the interview, this applicant demonstrates active involvement in community and/or scholarly activities and demonstrates a firm grasp of what medical school is like and why he/she is interested in medicine. This is the type of applicant who has unique or impressive activities.

**(A=3)** Warrants a Hold Alternate letter. This is a good candidate who may be able to handle the academic, interactive and emotional demands of a medical education. The applicant is lacking communication skills during the interview or participation in scholarly or humanitarian activities.

**(R=4)** Warrants a Reject letter. The R stands for Reservation(s) about the applicant. This is a weak applicant for whom there are serious concerns regarding the ability to handle either the academic, interactive and/or emotional demands of medicine. It is unlikely that this applicant will be successful in medical school or as a physician. He/she has had a weak interview and it is unlikely that this applicant will be accepted.
