Reciprocal Credits for the MD/MPH program

Students enrolled in the joint MD/MPH program may reciprocally apply coursework toward the fulfillment of the requirements of both the MD and the MPH degree requirements.

Up to and including six credits of coursework taken in the Public Health program may fulfill degree requirements for the MD degree. Eligible courses are:

- MPHP 628/PRVM 6423 – Service Learning and Community Health
- MPHP 629/PRVM 6429 – Refugee Health in the Community
- MPHP 647 – Research and Writing for Public Health
- MPHP 649/FAMP 1649 -- Public Health and Biopsychosocial Primary Care
- MPHP 655 – Advanced Epidemiology
- MPHP 661 – Advanced Biostatistics
- MPHP 699 -- Culminating Experience

The Research and Writing for Public Health (MPHP 647), Advanced Epidemiology (MPHP 655), Advanced Biostatistics (MPHP 661), or Culminating Experience (MPHP 699) courses may be used to fulfill the basic science selective requirement.

Up to and including six and one half credits taken in the Medicine program may fulfill degree requirements for the MPH degree (Population Health for Clinicians Concentration only). Eligible courses include:

- MPTP 101 – Patients to Populations (2.5 credits)
- MPPH 203 – Foundations of Reasoning in Medicine (2.5 credits)
- CBHX 2400 -- Clinical Bioethics (1 credit)
- PRVM 6400 – Population Health for Physicians (0.5 credit)
