

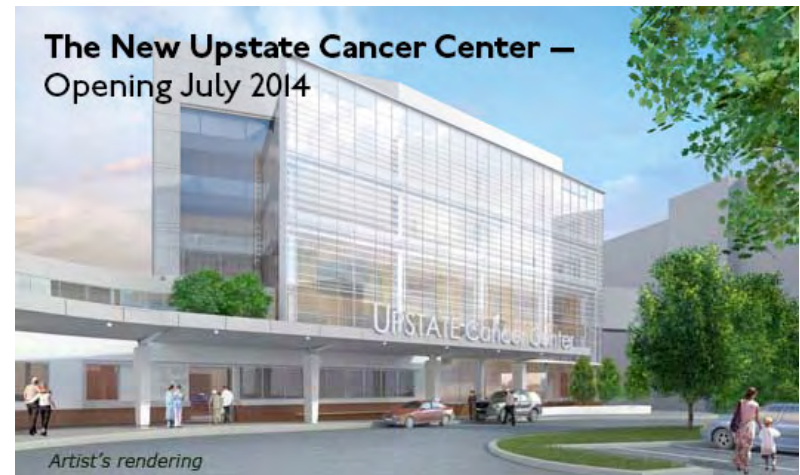
SUNY Upstate Medical University: Beyond the Numbers



SUNY Upstate Medical University and its affiliated University Hospital are Central New York's only academic medical center. With the acquisition of Community General Hospital in 2011, the two-hospital system now has a combined 715 beds. With nearly 9,000 employees, Upstate is also Onondaga county's largest employer. University Hospital is a tertiary-care referral hospital and the only Level One Trauma Center in Central New York. The Hospital's coverage area of 17 counties is the broadest of the region's hospitals.
