Preferred Name and Gender Identity



On <u>Saturday October 20, 2018</u>, Upstate will upgrade its current Epic system to the latest version of Epic (Epic v.2018). As with any upgrade, users can expect to see a number of changes and / or new features in the system.

Epic v.2018 includes <u>changes of great importance to our</u> patients, their safety and care, and to our staff related to a patient's preferred name and gender identity.

Patient Name Terminology



Term	Defined as:
Legal Name	The name that identifies a person for legal or official purposes.
Preferred Name	The name that may be chosen to be used instead of the legal first name.

Important Note: The Preferred Name field is <u>not to be used for</u> phonetic pronunciation, legal first name, or comments / notes. The purpose of the Preferred Name field is to capture the name by which a patient wishes to be called. Related, the Preferred Name Type field will be populated by default by Epic and <u>should not be modified by any user</u>. If Preferred Name Type is deleted, Epic will auto-populate it again, but if a user modifies the information in this field it may cause print / display issues.

Patient Sex Terminology



Term	Defined as:
Sex Assigned at Birth	The sex (male or female) assigned a child at birth, based on a child's genitalia.
Birth Sex	Synonym for Sex Assigned at Birth
Natal Sex	Synonym for Sex Assigned at Birth
Sex (Legal)	The sex that is listed on legal or official documents.

Gender Terminology



Term	Defined as:
Gender Identity	A person's internal sense of being; a man, woman, both, or neither. Gender identity usually develops at a young age.
Binary Gender (Gender Binary)	Gender as two distinct classifications, masculine (male) or feminine (female).
Cisgender (Cisgender male or cisgender female)	Gender identity that corresponds to birth sex.
Non-Binary Gender	Gender that is something other than male or female.
Transgender	People whose gender identity is not the same as the sex they were assigned at birth.
Female-to-Male (Transgender Male)	A person born with female genitalia at birth who feels they are male / a man and lives as a male / a man. Some will just use the term male.
Male-to-Female (Transgender Female)	A person born with male genitalia who feels they are female / a woman and lives as female / a woman. Some will just use the term female.

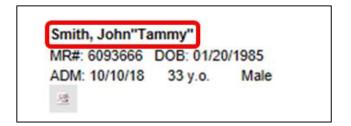



Patient Header Updates



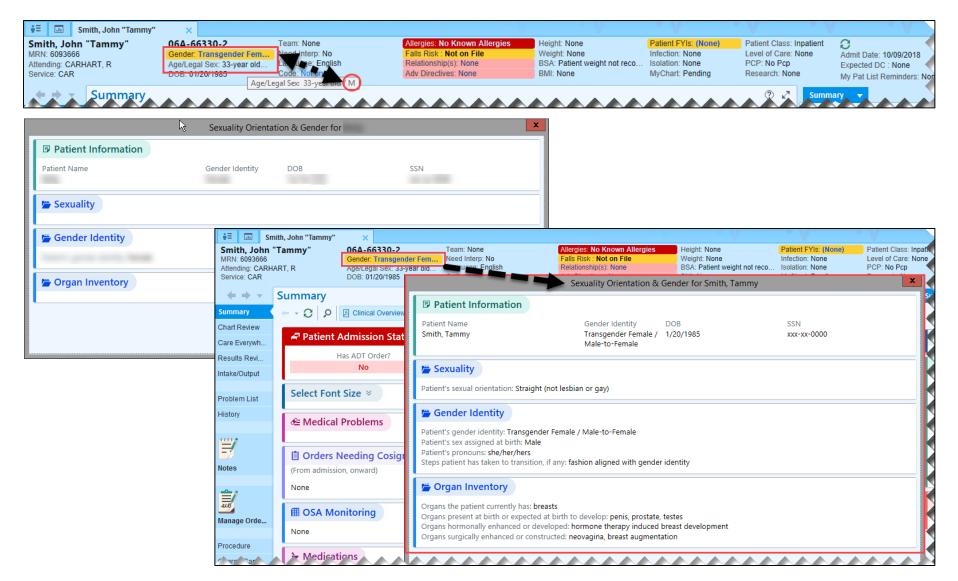
All users can expect to notice changes in the Patient Header related to Preferred Name and Gender Identity.

- The Patient Header is the most reliable and consistent display of patient sex and gender at the time of Epic v.2018 upgrade on October 20, 2018.
- To accommodate new fields and displays of information in the header, some items may have moved in the Patient Header.
- Gender in the Patient Header will be highlighted in yellow if Epic notices a mismatch in documented gender, sex, and sex assigned at birth.
- Users can click on Gender in the Patient Header to be directed to the Sexual Orientation and Gender report that will provide important data related to the patient's gender identity, sexuality, and organ inventory.

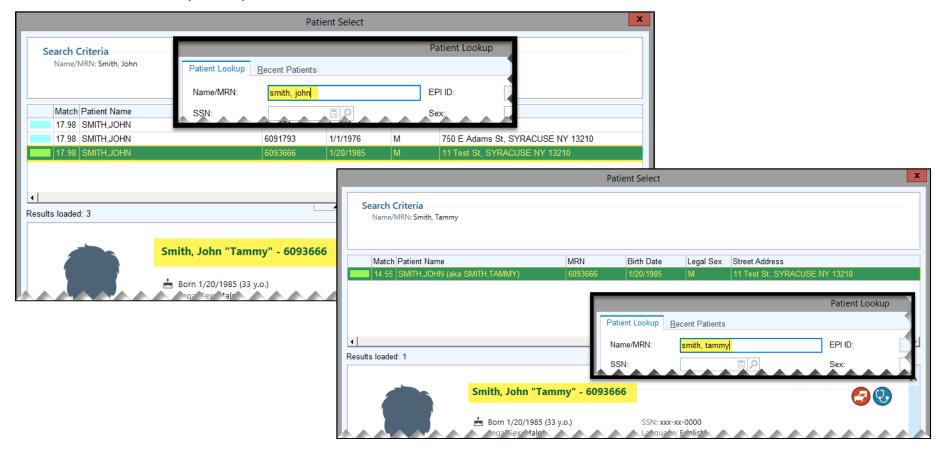




Patient Lookup



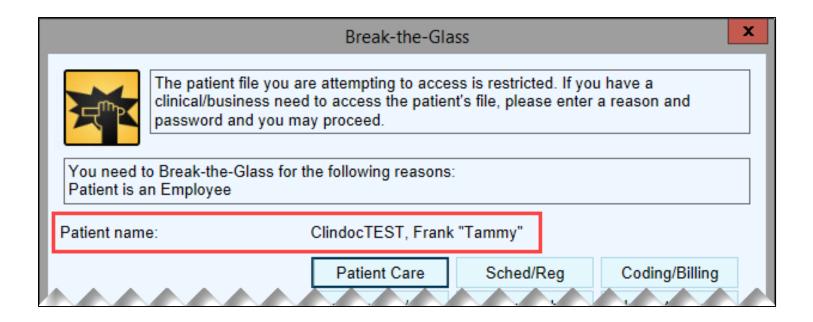
Patient Lookup will recognize and search on both a patient's legal and a patient's preferred name. For example, Smith, John "Tammy" can be found when searching for Smith, John and when searching for Smith, Tammy. Users can also search for patients by Medical Record Number (MRN).



Break-the-Glass



Both a patient's Legal Name and their Preferred Name will display on Break-the-Glass prompts formatted as Legal Last Name, Legal First Name "Preferred Name".



In Basket



The In Basket sidebar when reviewing a message will display different information based on the folder in which you are viewing messages. Most will display Legal Last Name, Preferred Name and Gender Identity. Most importantly, critical folders such as Results and Rx Requests will have a print group displaying Demographic Information.

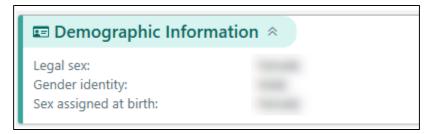

SmartLinks



SmartLinks help users to customize their documentation (i.e., in notes or letters) by pulling data from the patient's chart. Many SmartLinks are available for patient name, gender, and sex. With the changes for Preferred Name and Gender Identity, new SmartLinks are available and the description of each is clearly defined so users are aware of exactly what will populate when using a specific SmartLink.
