EASY WAYS TO ROCK AT EMPLOYEE RECOGNITION

Why is **employee recognition** so important? Employees are much more likely to stay if their efforts are appreciated, valued and acknowledged. Plus, showing appreciation to staff for their contributions can **boost morale** and productivity.



Here are some employee recognition ideas to consider:

1. Say thanks

Regularly acknowledge employees' great work verbally. Point out how their efforts will help the company, or assist patients and families.

2. Put it in writing

Prepare a handwritten thank you note or copy administration on an e-mail about an employee's accomplishment.

3. Publicize achievements

Feature standout employees in a newsletter or recognize them at a staff meeting.

4. Keep a record

Save reminders of each employee's contributions so you have that information handy and can refer to it during performance reviews.

5. Spread the word

Share a message sent by a customer or colleague applauding the work of a fellow staff member

6. Let them show off

Arrange for team members to present the results of a project to administration.

7. Encourage professional development

Allow staff to participate in work-related associations and conferences.

8. Support continuing education

Embrace educational opportunities for staff to advance their knowledge and/or degree.

9. Award them

Nominate staff for external or internal accolades.

10. Meet and eat

Treat your direct reports to lunch to discuss career goals and department objectives.

11. Show your appreciation

Hand out personalized certificates or plaques for accomplishments.

12. Treat them

Bring in goodies like cupcakes or doughnuts for the team to enjoy.

13. Celebrate milestones

Organize team get-togethers to recognize the completion of a project or special events, such as work anniversaries.

14. Introduce them to leadership

Reward workers by inviting leadership to a staff meeting or luncheon.

15. Develop leaders

Recognize an employee's skill by asking him or her to mentor others.

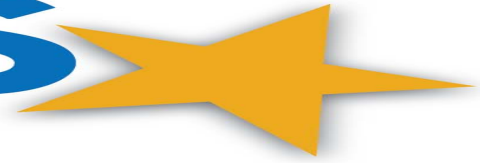
