#### Physician Suspension Practice by Andrea Bleyle

Last spring CMS announced Waivers allowing hospitals to relax the normal regulations for Provider Suspension for late documentation in the Medical Record as defined in the Medical Staff Bylaws. This allowed providers to focus on patient care and the challenges they faced during the crisis. As we are now returning to a more normal status and few COVID patients, it is necessary to restart our suspension process.

Beginning next week, we will resume the tracking and process of suspending providers. Please make sure your documentation is completed within 12 days of discharge to avoid suspension. Also, the Physician Dictation Room is open Monday – Friday from 7:00 am – 4:30 pm should you require assistance.

#### **Revised Policies**

- Infection Control for Aerosol Generating Procedures During COVID-19 (COV A-02): added CPAP/BiPAP patient's to exclusion list, added #18 and #19 on page 2.
- <u>COVID-19: Bed Management and Throughput (COV B-03)</u>: updated the use of ID Now platform for EDs.
- <u>Discontinuation of Transmission Based Precautions of Patients with COVID-19 (COV D-04)</u>: changed policy to move to a time-based symptom strategy for isolation removal, defined test-based strategy and management of patients 10-20 days post COVID positive test.

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- <u>COVID-19/SARS-CoV-2 Testing Standing Order and Protocol (COV T-07)</u>: added inpatient and COVID testing site protocols.
- <u>COVID-19 Testing at Upstate University Hospital Locations (COV T-08)</u>: updated use of rapids for newly symptomatic inpatients, updated inpatient saliva test criteria.

Please validate with the baseline Creatinine (SCr), and include any additional evaluation, treatment and monitoring in your documentation. Also include the **underlying etiology.** Your complete documentation will give Upstate the opportunity to continue providing the best care to our community! ## Wash Away the "Dirty Dozen"

## Swipe Sense tip sheet

- 1. "Address" the soap/santizer dispenser head on
- 2. Watch for the green light at the base of the dispenser-the green light indicates "credit" for the washing
- 3. Wear your badge at shoulder height for the best result
- 4. Do not place your vocera and your swipe sense badge near each other on your lanyard
- 5. If you wear swipesense in your pocket do not put near any device with an antenna (cell phone)
- 6. Upstate policy you must wash when crossing "in to" and "out of" every patient room
- 7. Exit one room immediately enter the next room your "wash out" counts for the "wash in" in the next room
- 8. Swipe sense provides "credit" for a patient room entry when you remain in the room for longer than 1 minute
- 9. Credit when hands are washed within 60 seconds of entering or exiting a room
- 10. Don't hover in the doorway..... stand at least one foot away from the door
- 11. Hand Sanitizer on carts does not count toward swipe sense tracking
- 12. Know your data.....you might be surprised



## UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL Clinical Documentation Improvement Tip of the Month – Renal Failure Applies to all providers

#### Acute Renal Failure (AKI) is defined by:

Increase in Serum Creatinine by > 0.3 mg/dl (> 26.5 mmol/l) above the baseline within 48 hours

Increase in Serum Creatinine to > 1.5 times the patient's baseline level, which is known or presumed to have occurred within the prior 7 days

Urine volume < 0.5 ml/kg/h for 6 hours

KDIGO definition (derived from AKIN and Acute Dialysis Quality Initiative (ADQI) RIFLE criteria)

Baseline creatinine is defined as the lowest creatinine value recorded for that patient in the preceding 3 months and must be documented to support your diagnosis.

#### **Acute Tubular Necrosis**

Causes of ATN

Contrast nephropathy (following CT scan,	Medications (Antibiotics, Antifungals,
cardiac catheterization)	Immunosuppressive agents, etc.)
Prolonged ischemia, hypotension and/or	Rhabdomyolysis
shock	
Sepsis	Hypovolemia

#### When to consider documenting Acute Tubular Necrosis:

- Acute Kidney Failure lasts for > 3 days after fluid resuscitation
- Your patient's urinalysis demonstrates significant proteinuria, muddy brown casts, or epithelial

cell casts

• Your patient's Fractional Excretion of Sodium (FeNa) is > 2 %

#### **Chronic Kidney Disease**

Renal function is categorized based on estimated GFR.

CKD Stage 1	GFR >90 ml/min
CKD Stage 2	GFR 60-89 ml/min
CKD Stage 3	GFR 30-59 ml/min
CKD Stage 4	GFR 15-29 ml/min
CKD Stage 5	GFR <15 without dialysis
End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD)	Chronic hemo or peritoneal dialysis
