

On January 15, 2020, we will activate the Medication Administration Record (MAR) for physicians in EPIC. The intention is that more ready access to the MAR will help reduce medication errors, omissions, and duplications. The activation of the MAR should not change the current work flow. With rare pre-existing exceptions, medication administration and documentation should still be in the nurse work flow. Please refer to the attached tip sheet for more information.

Overview of Feature / Changes

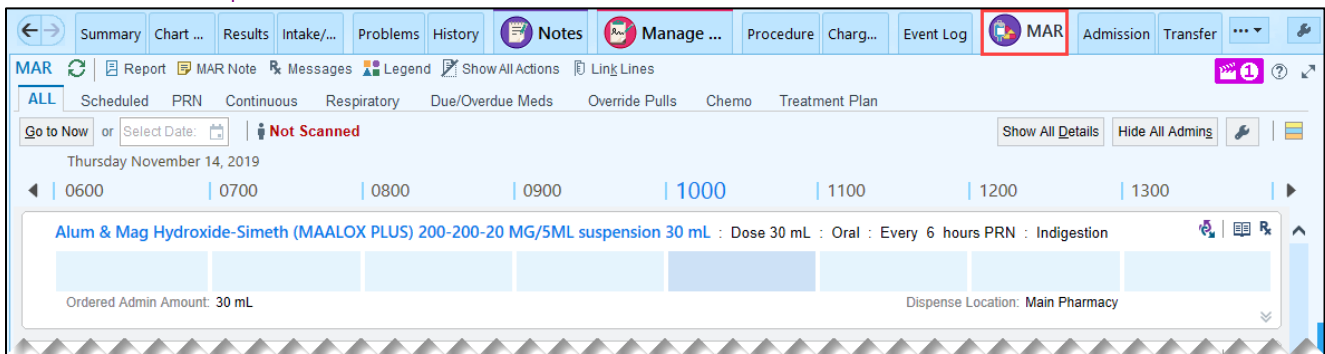
Effective Wednesday January 15, 2020, the Medication Administration Record (MAR) activity will be available as a default activity tab for Inpatient and Emergency Providers (MD, Resident, PA, NP) including Golisano Pediatrics After Hours. Licensed providers will have full access while Medical, NP, and PA Students will have read-only access to the MAR.

Access to the MAR activity will allow providers to **view information from the nursing perspective**. This is beneficial to the clinical team members for **collaboration and patient care**.

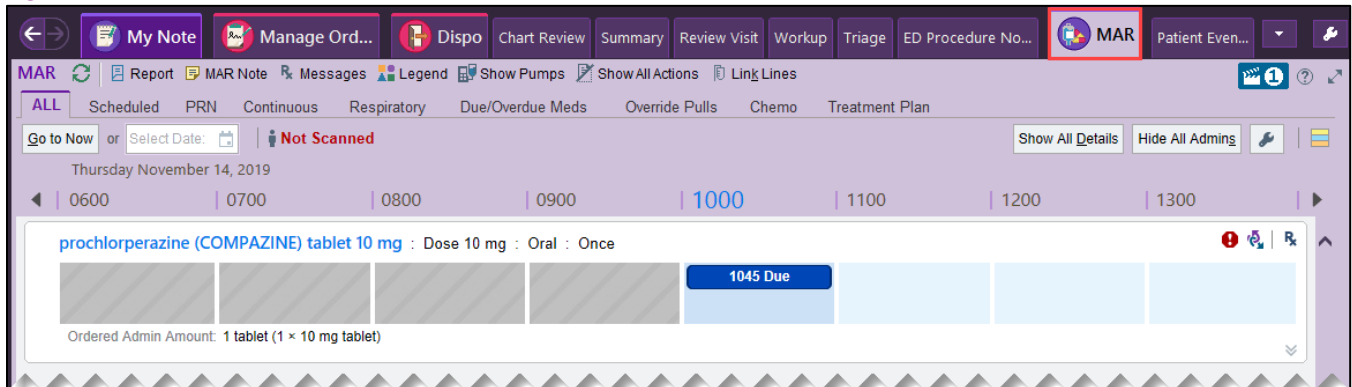
