The Eastern Farm Workers Association (EFWA) is looking for physicians to participate in a general medical session in the Tully area on Saturday, January 14, at 6 pm.

The EFWA is a volunteer run organization that helps low income working families. They provide benefits to its members such as food, clothing, dental, legal and medical services. One of the medical services provided by the EFWA are general medical sessions where doctors, students, and volunteers go out to the area where the workers are located and provide check-ups for them in order to discover any chronic conditions they may have.

For Saturday's event, there will be an orientation session from 4 pm – 5 pm at the EFWA main office located at 525 North Salina Street, Syracuse, NY 13208. Then, they will head to the Tully location to set up before the workers arrive around 6 pm. Students will serve as medical liaisons for the assigned patient and have the opportunity to take a history, vitals, and practice medical Spanish. Afterwards, the student and patient will meet with the physician to go over the patient's history and health goals along with any physician findings.
