It is with great sadness that I share with you the news of Dr. William Marx's unexpected passing on Wednesday, February 9, 2022. Dr. Marx has been a valued member of our Upstate family since 1993 and will be deeply missed.

Dr. Marx's long-standing career includes service at Upstate University Hospital and the VA Medical Center in Syracuse. He was Professor of Surgery and Critical Care and Chief of the Division of Trauma and Acute Care Surgery at Upstate University Hospital. As the Chief of Trauma and Acute Care Surgery at Upstate, Dr. Marx developed an outstanding team of surgeons, nurses, surgical specialists, and support staff.

Dr. Marx was passionate about Trauma Surgery and was an actively engaged leader in the trauma community at both the state and national levels through numerous professional affiliations, including the American College of Surgeons, the Bureau of EMS and Trauma Systems, and the State Trauma Advisory Committee. Dr. Marx served on the American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma and as the Chair of the NY State Trauma Advisory Committee.
