Administration of Chemotherapy via Lumbar Puncture or Intraventricular Reservoir

Expectations for privileges: All providers (Physicians and APP) that administer Intrathecal Chemotherapy
Initial Privileges – Review of policies and education, 5 direct observations of successful administration via Lumbar Puncture (LP) and Intraventricular Reservoir
Annual Requirements to Maintain Privileges – Annual education and policy review, 1 direct observation of successful administration via LP and Intraventricular Reservoir

Medical Staff Office will provide final approval of privileges and maintenance of training records. Verification of privileges is available across the institution within the E-priv application.
