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Transitional Care Unit (TCU) Clarification

TCU Informational To clarify last week's memo regarding the Transitional Care Unit (TCU) at our Community Campus, which is anticipated to open July 28, 2014, <u>admissions will be limited to Medicare patients at this time</u>. Again, a clear discharge plan prior to admission is necessary; there are no direct admissions or readmissions to the TCU. For TCU patients, the billing and documentation requirements follow nursing home rules rather than hospital rules.

MRI Informational Although, Radiology at the Community Campus has added On-Call Coverage to their MRI hours of operation from 8 am to 8 pm every Saturday and Sunday and hospital holidays, please note, <u>no elective contrast studies are performed "off hours."</u> There is a process in place to be able to perform emergent contrast studies.

To obtain an emergency MRI exam during on-call coverage hours, call the Radiology department at 492-5527 and on-duty Radiology staff will call the MRI technologist to report to work.

ALERT-Highest priority emergency communication; warrants immediate action or attention by the recipient.

HIGH ADVISORY-High priority does not warrant immediate action but recipients should be aware.

ADVISORY-Provides very important information for a specific incident or situation that does not require immediate action.

UPDATES TO ALERTS AND ADVISORIES-Provides updated information regarding an incident or situation; unlikely to require immediate action.

INFORMATIONAL MESSAGE-Provides timely information, important for review or serves as a reminder for an action that should be taken.
