Changes in Hospital Geography: Medical Intensive Care Unit & Surgical Intensive Care Unit Applies to All Providers

MICU & SICU Alert Just a reminder that effective Monday, January 5, 2015, two major changes in hospital geography will occur:

- 1. The existing MICU on 8E will be moved to 6I. Unifying the Medical ICU services in one area on the 6th floor will allow for better coverage options for both residents and nursing staff.
- 2. **Also, the SICU on 6I will move to 8E.** SICU will be in closer proximity to critically ill thoracic and vascular patients already placed on the 8th floor.

We hope these changes will have beneficial effects on staff and patient care. I appreciate the thoughtful multidisciplinary discussions that have taken place to plan for this.
