Description

The integration of primary care and public health is a national “hot topic,” spurring small and large scale research, clinical and educational endeavors. Perhaps inevitably, there is already some backlash to this concept, arguing that integration causes dilution and confounding of the purposes of each discipline. In this talk, we will explore the roots of both primary care and public health, review some previous forms of integration, and compare and contrast the primary purposes of each. We will also discuss some local, regional and national initiatives that are attempting this integration. Are public health and primary care linked at a primary level, or are they so fundamentally different that there is no hope of true integration?
