Description: The indoor environment affects the health and comfort of occupants. Young children are of particular concern as they spend most of their time indoors. This presentation will focus on results from a research study investigating indoor environmental exposures and symptoms of early respiratory and allergic disease among a cohort of infants of low income families in Syracuse. The presentation will also describe indoor air pollution from household biomass burning; a major environmental health risk in many developing countries.
