Subj: **InSure ONE Immunochemical Fecal Occult Blood Test**

University Hospital Microbiology Laboratory is now offering the InSure ONE (Clinical Genomics) immunochemical fecal occult blood test for **outpatient testing only**. We will continue to accept Hemoccult ICT cards but ask that you transition to the InSure ONE product.

InSure advantages

- Allows sample collection from a single bowel movement instead of the 2-3 recommended for our current immunochemical test, the Hemoccult ICT (Beckman Coulter)
- Only requires a sample of water from the toilet bowl after the stool surface has been brushed
- No special dietary restrictions are required

InSure limitations

- As with the Hemoccult ICT, both tests are specific for bleeding in the lower gastrointestinal (GI) tract, therefore, it is unlikely to be positive in patients with upper GI bleeding

Specimen

- Acceptable – Inoculated card received ≤14 days after collection
- Unacceptable – Raw or preserved stool, inoculated card received > 14 days after collection

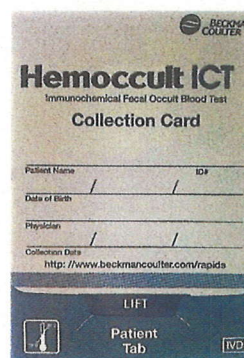
