



ACETAMINOPHEN

THE MOST COMMON DRUG INGREDIENT

- Found in over 600 different prescription & OTC medicines
- In pain & fever relievers, sleep aids, cough, cold, & allergy meds
- Can be labelled as acetaminophen, as "APAP", "acetam"
- Used as directed, it is safe and effective
- BUT there is a daily limit
- **Taking more than directed is an overdose**
- It can lead to liver damage
- Know your dose
- Always read & follow the label
- Never take 2 medicines with acetaminophen at the same time
