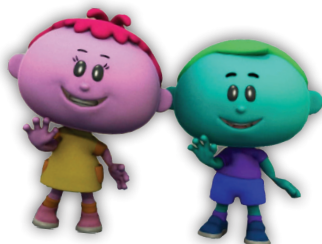
Now that you have found the poisons in your home, be poison safe!
