- A child just emptied out the bleach bottle left under a sink.
- You gave your son medication but forgot to tell your husband, who gave it again.
- Your daughter got into your aunt's medicine, stored in a suitcase.
- Playing with a toy, a child in your care ingested a button battery.
- Taking a cold medicine you want to know if you should avoid taking another medicine for a headache.
- Your grandchild may have breathed in some harsh chemicals while you were cleaning.
- You are wondering how you should get rid of unwanted, outdated medications.
- By mistake, someone drank a floor cleaner left in a cup on the counter.
- A child reached for the eye drops and some may have gotten into her eyes.
- Superglue was used by mistake instead of eye drops.
