



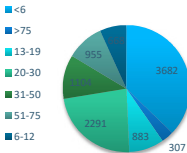
# Upstate New York Poison Center Q1 2025 Report

At the Upstate New York Poison Center, we managed **10,291** exposure cases during the first quarter of 2025 (January to March). The data indicates a higher incidence of unintentional substance exposures compared to intentional exposures.

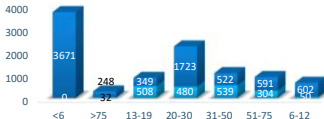
 We managed **7,299** cases at Home, including exposures at both own residences and workplaces

Intentional Cases Unintentional Cases

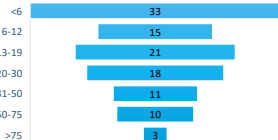

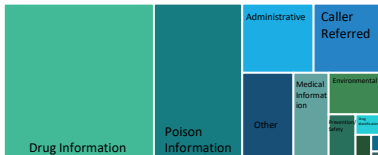
## HOW DO CANNABIS-RELATED CASES VARY BY SUBSTANCE TYPE AND AGE GROUP?
