\*Project ECHO (Strategic Tier I Objective – Increase Reputation for Excellence): Aimed to increase access & build capacity in primary care areas

- •NYS grant awarded Endocrine (Diabetes)
- •Implemented Geriatric & Pediatric ECHO clinics
  - o Results from Pediatrics experience accepted via peer review for National meeting presentation in Fall 2018
  - o Pediatrics: 7 different specialists presenting on 6 specialties Pulmonology, Gastroenterology, Infectious Disease Neurology, Environmental Health, Endocrinology
  - o Since January 2018 there have been 14 ECHO clinics (3 Geriatrics, 11 Pediatrics)
    - 49 unique attendees & 8 counties represented (Onondaga, Broome, Oneida, Monroe, Tompkins, St. Lawrence, Lewis, Otsego)
    - Averaging 11 participants per clinic
    - Partnering with 2 Residency programs: Mohawk Valley Health System & Lourdes
