

# Bleeding Control Basics Course - Becoming an Instructor

Who can become an instructor?

Eligible instructors for the Bleeding Control Basic Course include:

- Any MD, DO, RN, CRNA, NP, PA, DDS, DMD, DVM, PharmD, LVN, LPN, RD, RT, PT, OT, Paramedic, EMT, EMR/First Responder, Ski Patrol, Athletic Trainer, TCCC-MP Provider (both actively practicing and retired providers are eligible to be instructors) who has successfully completed the Bleeding Control Basic Course
- Any PHTLS instructor who has successfully completed the Bleeding Control Basic Course
- Any TCCC/TECCC instructor who has successfully completed the Bleeding Control Basic Course
- Any ATCN/TNCC instructor who has successfully completed the Bleeding Control Basic Course
- Any ATLS instructor who has successfully completed the Bleeding Control Basic Course
- Any NAEMT instructor who has successfully completed the Bleeding Control Basic Course

Can medical, nursing, or EMT students become bleeding control instructors?

Students in any of our approved instructor categories are currently eligible to become bleeding control associate instructors. They can assist an approved instructor with teaching a class, but they cannot set up or teach classes on their own until they complete their student status.

How do I become an instructor?

If you have taken a Bleeding Control Basic Course, simply go to [BleedingControl.org](https://BleedingControl.org) to register. Click on the Instructor Portal, review the Instructor Manual and Course Guidelines, then look for the link that says “please CLICK HERE for the new Instructor registration request.” From there, you will be able to request for approval to become an Instructor. In less than 48 hours, your registration will be approved and you can begin to help others STOP THE BLEED.

How long after taking a bleeding control class do I need to wait to register to become an approved instructor?

You can register for approval to become an instructor immediately after completing a Bleeding Control Basic Course.
