PURPOSE AND GOALS

Trauma care involves the entire spectrum of care from the first responder thru rehabilitation. The successful outcome of a resuscitation of a seriously injured patient is determined by the skill levels of many health care providers and their ability to function in as a team.

The Trauma Service at Upstate University Hospital, is a Level I Adult and Level I Pediatric trauma program. These programs work synergistically to provide comprehensive trauma care for all ages. As the only Level I center in Central New York, our responsibility is to support the entire CNY Trauma Region.
