## **Overview of Feature / Changes**

Beginning on Wednesday, October 19, 2022, patients will be able to add whether or not they have received a vaccine via their MyChart account.


This will be available for all vaccine types. When a patient adds a vaccine via MyChart, this will satisfy their Health Maintenance topic for that immunization, however it will not become a part of Upstate's Local Medical Record until a clinical user reconciles it in Epic.

## How It Works

Patients may see cards on their MyChart News Feed that let them know that they have an overdo Health Maintenance topic, such as a vaccine.



By clicking the link on the card or navigating to the **Preventive Care Activity**, patients can view all of these for which they are overdo.




If a patient has had one of these vaccines, they will now be able to denote that using the **Mark as Complete** button and entering the date on which they received it.

MyChart: Patient Entered Immunizations

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Once a patient submits an immunization, it can be reconciled via the **Reconcile Outside Information Activity** in Epic. This can be accessed via banners in activities like the **SnapShot** or **Immunizations** or by doing a Chart Search for **Reconcile Outside Information**.



Once the immunization is reconciled, any necessary information can be updated via the **Immunizations Activity**.
