Dear students,

Prometric has just released a new announcement regarding testing center closures. You can view this on their website: <https://www.prometric.com/corona-virus-update>Prometric has stated that test centers will remain closed through May 31 “with the exception of a limited set of essential services programs”.

At this time, there has been no announcement of whether USMLE exams will be considered essential services programs. We do not have any further knowledge of this. We are hopeful that USMLE exams, being part of the healthcare sector, will be considered essential.

Prometric did state that “if your exam appointment is impacted by these closure extensions, you will receive an email notification informing you that your appointment has been canceled, and instructions for how to reschedule for a future date.” If you have not received such an email, we suggest you continue to prepare for your currently scheduled exam date.

We know that this continues to be a frustrating and uncertain situation. Please know that we will continue to monitor and will keep you updated.
