

## **6/25/2020 – Travel Advisory Update**

Dear students,

There is a new Travel Advisory from the state of NY that requires a 14 day quarantine of individuals coming into NY state from states with higher rates of COVID. Please read the attached advisory. If you are currently out of the state and this quarantine would apply to you, please contact the coordinator for your first clerkship as soon as possible to notify them of this required quarantine. We suggest you consider adjusting your travel plans to shorten the amount of clerkship time missed for quarantine. The nature and timing of makeup activity for clerkship time missed due to quarantine will be determined by the clerkship.

NY State has announced that an updated list of which states will be impacted by this order will be maintained on the NY State website, based on positive test rates of COVID. For now, the states impacted are: Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, Florida, North Carolina, South Carolina, Texas and Utah
